"NEXT YEAR IN JERUSALEM" PAPER MOSAIC INSTRUCTION SHEET



Materials: 1/2 sheet paper, scissors, glue stick, magazine, pencil Magazine Cutout Colors: sandy + stone texture, cream, yellow, brown, black, green, shades of blue







STEP 1

Fold your paper in half. Measure two inches from the bottom of your page and make a mark. Fill in this bottom section with two rows of different colored rectangular stones, glue your pieces down.

STEP 2

Start cutting out your city and gluing your pieces to the paper. You can reference the shapes in the image. None of these buildings are actually real! The key to making this look like Jerusalem is to use sand and stone textured magazine clippings and stack your buildings vertically.

Tip: when you are making a dome, make sure to make the half circle shape the same width as the building.

STEP 3

Cut out and glue down a yellow sun (does not have to be a perfect circle). Using your many shades of blue, fill in the sky glueing each piece as you go, use a variety of shapes. This might take a while -- but stick with it!



STEP 4

Glue down a few cypress trees to the scene using green and brown. Also, don't forget to add black windows and doors to the buildings. You can reference the shapes below.
